## YOUTH CONFERENCE: Frequently Asked Questions

### **What does it cost? – Updated 2017**

**\$40 Registration**, which includes all activity fees and meals. Youth Workers will be charged \$20. We will provide all meals from Thursday supper through Saturday breakfast if you lodge with us. If you provide your own lodging, you will be on your own for breakfast each day.

### **What are the dates and times?**

Youth Conference registration begins at 11:30am on Thursday morning, April 27th. The first service will begin at 1:00pm. Please plan on arriving by 12:30pm so that we can begin at 1:00pm. There are many local restaurants that you could visit if you would like to register and then go get lunch before the first service at 1:00pm. The conference ends at noon on Saturday, April 29th.

### **What about lodging?**

Lodging will be provided in the homes of our church members if you have requested it by April 19th. We will need to know how many teens and workers will need lodging. You should bring your own towels and a sleeping bag in case they are needed. If you would like to stay at a hotel, we have arranged special pricing at a couple of nearby hotels, or you can try to see if you can get a better deal on your own.

### **Who can attend the Youth Conference?**

Any young person in grade six through those teens that are one year out of high school may attend. We ask that you not bring children to the daytime sessions unless you are prepared to watch them yourself in our nursery. Nursery will be available for the evening services. Every group present should include at least one adult (if at all possible). Please feel free to call if you have any questions.

### **When and how should I register?**

You may register upon arrival on April 27th. You may send one cheque (Payable to “Heritage Baptist Church”) to cover the entire group, or bring cash. Please let us know by April 19th how many are coming. If possible, please also send us a list of names and ages of the teens coming. You can always bring more workers or teens, but it is important to let us know who and how many are coming.

### **What should I wear?**

**Youth Workers, please make sure your teens know this before they come.**

**Young Ladies** should wear modest, loose fitting culottes, skirts or dresses for all services and activities. These must be at least knee length. We ask that slits not be any higher than the knee. No pants. Nice dresses should be worn in the evening services.

**Young Men** should wear collared shirts or dress clothes in the services. T-shirts may be worn for activities, but should not contain questionable pictures or emblems. No shorts.
